Rules:

Categories will include Open Women, Open Men, Open mixed and whatever other categories come about over the series.

Points will be awarded as follows:

5 points for first place in category

4 points for second

3 points for third

2 points for fourth

1 point for fifth

Paddlers must race at least 3 out of 7 races to qualify for the series. If you race more than 5 races, your best 5 placings will be kept. If you are racing OC2, you must race with the same partner to accumulate the points. Paddlers will be awarded for points in the same category for each race (i.e. if you start out in Open you can't switch to Masters).

Prizes:

Series prizes were awarded for the three highest point accumulations in each category (if paddlers had raced in 3 events).
