



CORA Insurance Information (as of Jan. 2007)

All Sport Insurance handles the insurance for CORA paddlers. Liability insurance covers paddlers during practices and CORA sanctioned races, held by member clubs. All clubs must be paid up CORA clubs. All paddlers (not just racers) should be CORA members so that they have insurance coverage. Our policy number is AS3100. The coverage is:

Commercial General Liability:

Tenants Legal Liability-any one premises \$250,000 (\$500 deductible)

Medical Expense- any one person \$1,000

Errors & Omissions Liability \$2,000,000 (\$500 deductible)

(Directors & Officers / Wrongful Acts)

Non Owned Automobile \$5,000,000

Premium Basis \$4,375 approx. 875 members

Note: The insurance does not cover property (i.e. boats in clubhouse). Your club must hold that insurance.

Race Directors: Before you host a race, you need to contact All Sport Insurance to request a copy of the Certificate of Insurance for the race. A Harbour Master may request this certificate to assure the port authority that we have adequate coverage. Call All Sport and they'll know what you need. Advise them that your club is a member of CORA. If they ask for proof that your race is a CORA sanctioned race, point them to the schedule on our web site:
