



## CORA Cup Race Series

---

### OC6

The CORA Cup is awarded annually to the club with the most points in the races designated in the series. Crews are also rewarded for the top 3 in their respective age classes (see CORA rules for age classifications).

#### **There are six races in the 2009 CORA Cup series.**

Duel in the Desert: May 9th

Jericho Classic Iron: May 23<sup>rd</sup>

Island Iron: June 13<sup>th</sup>

Lotus Iron: June 27

VOS: July 11

CORA Nationals: August 15

#### **Points System**

##### **CORA Regular Calendar**

- 1st - 5 points
- 2nd - 4 points
- 3rd - 3 points
- 4th - 2 points
- 5th - 1.5 points
- All other crews 1 point

##### **CORA Nationals**

- 1st - 10 points
- 2nd - 8 points
- 3rd - 6 points
- 4th - 4 points
- 5th - 3 points
- All other crews: 2 points

#### **Rules**

- 1) Crews must participate in a minimum of 4 of the 6 events to qualify. The National championship is double the points.
- 2) Only CORA clubs and crews from those clubs are eligible for the Cup system.
- 3) Crews must participate under one club name.
- 4) A crews TOP FOUR results will be used to calculate your final total
- 5) Crew rosters may change but the crew must continue to use the same name AND age category throughout the season. We will not recognize a crew that has an ever-changing name.
- 6) Crews may be forced to race down an age class for the purposes of a specific race, however, the age category that you REGISTER in (and must be the same throughout the season) will be used to calculate the points. So please, do have the race directors know what age you are registering in for the Cup.
- 7) All CORA CLUBS will be counted throughout the season.
- 8) If it comes to the attention of the Race Director or Cup analyst that any of the above rules have been broken, then all crew rosters will be checked against the database and potential disqualification from the Cup series may occur.

## Small Boat Series

### Points System

#### CORA Regular Calendar

- 1st - 5 points
- 2nd - 4 points
- 3rd - 3 points
- 4th - 2 points
- 5th - 1 point

#### CORA Nationals

- 1st - 10 points
- 2nd - 8 points
- 3rd - 6 points
- 4th - 4 points
- 5th - 2 points

### Rules

- 1) Standard Categories include; Open (women, men and mixed). Other categories MAY arise over the season participation dependent.
- 2) Only FULL CORA members are eligible.
- 3) Paddlers must participate in at least four events and the top four will be used to calculate the total.
- 4) For the tandem event; the paddlers comprising the team can not change.
- 5) For all events, you must maintain the same age category throughout the season. The age category you register in will be used to calculate the points even if you are required to race down an age class in a specific event.
- 6) Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 per class and will be awarded at the National Championship.
- 7) If it comes to the attention of the Race Director or Cup analyst that any of the above rules have been broken, then all registration will be checked against the database and potential disqualification from the Cup series may occur.

### Notice Race Directors

- 1) Please ensure that in your race results, you also include the age category the crew actually REGISTERED in, even if they raced in another age class for your event.
- 2) Please ensure that all crews understand their names can not change throughout the year.
